#### **EARLY SUMMER MUSIC CAMP**

#### **JULY 4th PARADE**

Call time 9:30 AM (but plan on driving over early, as parking is always at a premium on parade day)
Parade Step off at 10:30 AM (we line up in the ACHS Parking lot and march down Main Street until we reach the library. Students will be dismissed from there. They will have to walk back to the band room to pack up. There is unfortunately no way we can drive the kids back to the school after the parade.

#### **COLOR GUARD EVENING CAMP**

July 11th, 12th, and 13th (4:00PM - 8:00PM)

The Color Guard will meet to continue to learn choreography for the show, football games, and assemblies. We will meet in the band room promptly at 4:00pm and will end at 8:00pm.

#### BAND CAMP WEEK (& RECAP)

August 1st - 5th (Noon to 9:00PM)

(Mini-performance for family and friends in the stadium at 8:00PM on Friday August 5th August 8 & 10 (6:00PM - 8:30 PM)

Band Camp is the week where the band learns the halftime show. The students are expected to know their music and choreography that was taught before they come to this camp so that the majority of the week can be used to learn all of the drill positions on the field. This week is extremely important to the success of our season because of the vast amount of material that is taught. If a student misses any day of this camp they will fall behind very quickly and may be considered an alternate.

<sup>\*</sup>This camp is required for all Color Guard members.

We will not accept absences for Band Camp Week unless a student is ill. If a student can not participate in band camp week, they are more than welcome to still be a part of the band, but they will be made an alternate for the show. The only permissible reason for missing camp and still earning a starting spot on the field is participation in DCI or other marching band related camps. Vacations, work, doctor's appointments, etc. are <a href="NOT">NOT</a> valid reasons. Below is a sample schedule of what a typical day of band camp week will look like. Times within the day may change depending on what the band is working on, but we will never let your students out late!

- Bring a sack lunch/dinner, or money for one of the fast food establishments across the street.
- Wear SCHOOL and WEATHER appropriate clothes that you can comfortably move around in.
- Bring sunscreen/hat/sunglasses in case we practice outside.
- Bring a water bottle!!!! Athletic hoses will be set up for kids to be able to refill.
- Meet in the ACHS Instrumental Room 143 in the morning.
- On the last day of camp, we will give a mini-performance for families in the stadium at 8:00 PM.

#### **FULL BAND REHEARSALS**

School year full band rehearsals will occur once per week from <u>6:00-8:30</u> beginning the first full week of school. We recommend students arrive by 5:15 to make it to the stadium on time. Students should wear <u>SCHOOL</u> and <u>WEATHER</u> appropriate, comfortable clothes and Drillmaster marching shoes/Color Guard shoes. Every student must be wearing these shoes to effectively work on the "roll-step."

#### Rehearsal/Performance Norms

- Arrive on time ("on time" is at LEAST 15 minutes early you will need to gather your instrument and/or equipment and be ready to go at practice/performance time).
- If you will be late or are not able to attend a practice or performance, please EMAIL and/or text (through the Remind app) either Mr. Untch (for wind and percussion) or Coach B (for color guard) ASAP.
- Showing up more than 30 minutes late is considered an absence.
- Absences for illness, religious activities, and/or a school related sport or activity are excused.
- Absences for work, a non-school related sport or activity, and all others are <u>UNEXCUSED</u>.
- Unexcused tardies and absences in addition to struggling with music, marching, and/or choreography will require make-up time or be moved to an alternate spot.
- Before leaving a rehearsal or performance, ALL members should check that instruments and equipment are put away, the band room/surrounding areas are clean, and the guard closet is clean.
- Do <u>NOT</u> leave without checking in with your section leader.
- You are responsible to make sure that your instrument/equipment makes it to the rehearsal/performance AND that it gets back after. Coordinate with your section leader or another band member to ensure that your instrument/equipment gets there AND back.
- Save the DRAMA for your llama. We are here to practice, perform, learn, and have fun.

#### **COLOR GUARD SECTIONALS**

Unless otherwise instructed, Color Guard will meet in the East Deck promptly at 3:30 on Thursdays (excect for Sept 1 and Sept 22). The Section Leader will begin warm ups and stretching. (Always check the whiteboard on the Color Guard Closet for updates!)

FOLLOW ALL REHEARSAL/PERFORMANCE NORMS (see above)!!!!

#### **REQUIRED FOR REHEARSAL**

At every rehearsal, ALL BAND MEMBERS must have the following:

- Dot Book and Drill Chart Binder
- Drillmaster Marching Shoes/Color Guard Shoes
- Instrument/Flags/Weapons/other props
- (Color Guard Only) Tape bag
- (Color Guard Only) Orange Shirt for Full Band Rehearsals

Marching Band Shirt for Games and Performances

#### FRIDAY AFTERNOON WORK SESSIONS

The Band Room will be open after school on Fridays from 3:30-4:15 for students who need help catching up on the music or marching. Students can work in small groups, or be able to work with a teacher one on one.

# <u>PERFORMANCES</u> (FOLLOW ALL REHEARSAL/PERFORMANCE NORMS - see above!!!!) Dates:

There are 4 or 5 home games per year. If the team has a home playoff game, we will perform. Details on playoff games won't be available until the week prior to the game, so we need to be flexible. In addition to home games, we will perform at a university band day, the 4th of July parade, the homecoming parade, and some school assemblies. Please see the calendars above and lists of dates below for more details.

  - Uniform, <u>BLACK</u> crew cut socks (NO low-cut or ankle socks),
     Drillmaster shoes, marching band t-shirt, white gloves



- Color Guard (NO jewelry!)
  - Uniform tunic, <u>BLACK</u> crew cut socks (NO low-cut or ankle socks),
     black leggings, color guard shoes, long sleeved black shirt (cold weather only)
  - Make up (on your own all makeup should be natural looking)
